**Registration Confirmation:** We will confirm each registration by email (if listed) or phone, before June 10<sup>th</sup>. If you have not received confirmation by then please contact us.

**Dress Code:** The NAA dress code will be in effect for all Official Practice rounds and competition. Skirts, skorts, shorts or trousers may be either white, navy blue or khaki and may be constructed of any suitable material other than blue denim. Shorts and skorts must reach the archer's fingertips when standing, as according to FITA rule 3.22.1.1, bullet 3. Blouses, collared shirts and T-shirts may be composed of any color or combination of colors. For women, all upper garment shoulder straps must conform to a three inches or larger strap width. Men are required to wear long or short-sleeved shirts. At no time may camouflage clothing be worn as an upper or lower body garment. Competitors must wear footwear at all times during the tournament. Each archer must comply with FITA regulation as well as the NAA dress code.

**Directions:** From 84 East, take Exit 70. At end of ramp, make a left and the fields are on the left hand side (0.1 miles off the exit) after commuter parking lot entrance.

From 84 West, take Exit 70. At end of ramp, make right and a quick left.

**Shooting Distances** – First two (longer) distances will be shot on a 122 cm face, second two (shorter) distances will be shot on a 80 cm face. This is a full FITA Tournament consisting of 144 arrows. The two longest distances will be shot on day one and the two shortest distances will be shot on day two.

The following distances apply to both Recurve and Compound:

**NOTE:** Archers may choose to compete in an older division. Barebow and longbow are adult divisions only.

**Shooting Times** – Check-in will begin at 8:30 AM, shooting will begin at 9:00 AM.

**Olympic Round** – We will conduct an Olympic Round on Sunday after the FITA Round has concluded for all who wish to participate.
